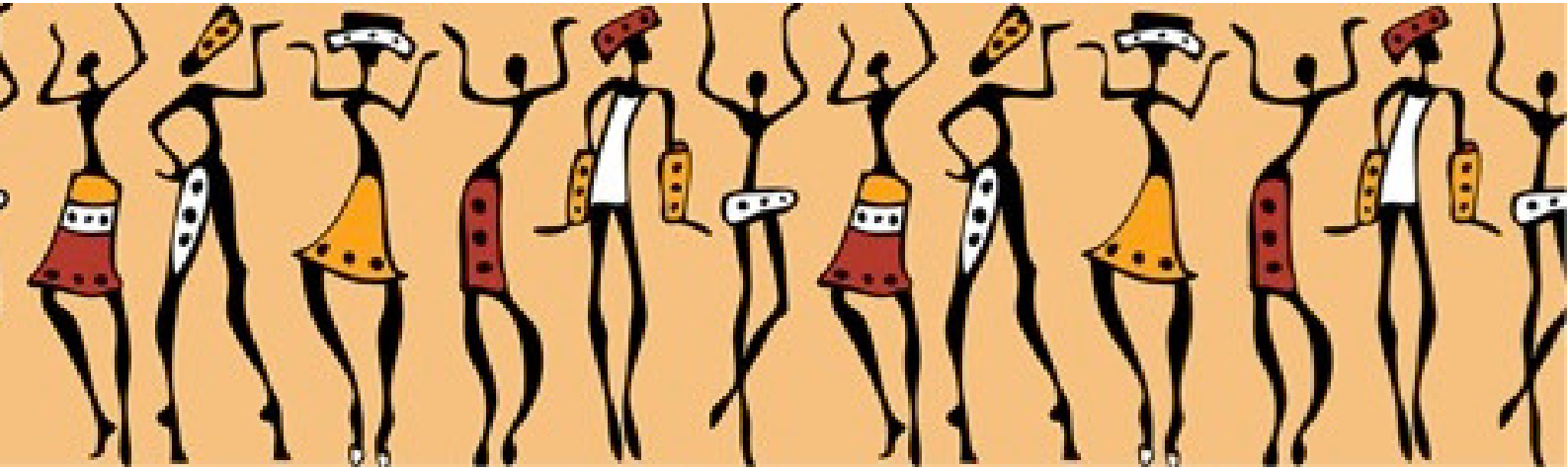

VISION

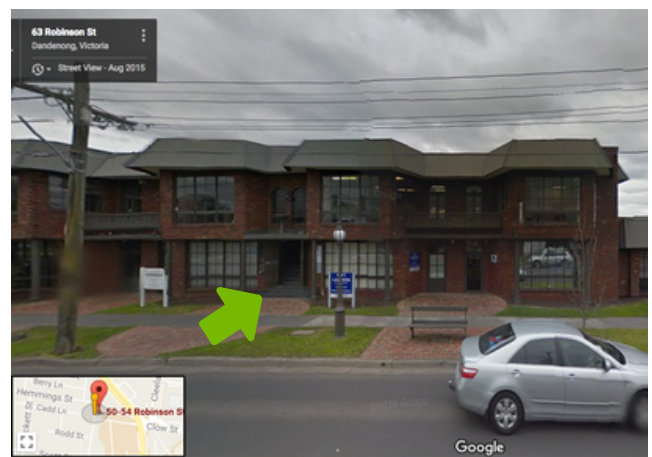

SLEEP WELL

Turning Plastic Bags Into Sleeping Mats For The Homeless

Transform all of those unwanted plastic shopping bags into something useful! By crocheting strips of plastic bags together, we can make a plastic sleeping mat, which can be distributed to homeless shelters. The plastic mats repel parasites are moisture resistant, durable, lightweight, easy to store, and make a great temperature barrier.

This is a wonderful project where people of all ages can combine their creativity, talents and labor to provide sleeping mats for individuals and organizations in need of protection from the elements, all by using plastic yarn made from plastic bags.

At Carers of Africa we collect and sort the donated bags. Our Volunteers carefully fold and cut the bags into strings called PLARN. This is then made into a ball of plarn which we use to crochet into a sleeping mat.

It takes roughly 600-700 plastic bags to make a single mat.

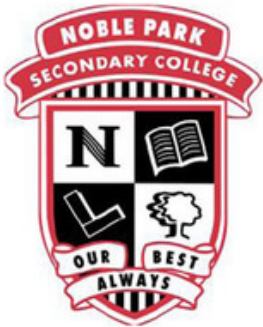
